GRADE 2

- 1 school box (approx.. 8"x5"x 3")
- 1 clipboard
- 1-2 large box(es) of tissues
- 2- 1" hard-sided three ring binder
- 2 pack of plastic pocketed binder dividers
- 1 box of Zip-loc type bags- (last name ending A-H SANDWICH bags; last names ending I-O GALLON bags; last names ending in P-Z SNACK sized bags)
- disinfectant or baby wipes
- One pair of scissors
- Four 3- pronged **PLASTIC** folders with pockets(1 Blue, 1 Yellow, 1 Purple and 1 Green)

GRADE 3

- 2 - 1" Clearview three ring binder
- 1 package 5 tab dividers
- 1 3 hole punch pencil bag
- 1 disinfectant wipes -- **BOYS**
- One pair of scissors
- 1 **PLASTIC** 2 pocket folder
- 8 **PLASTIC** pronged 2 pocket folders (2 red, 2 blue, 2 green, 2 yellow)
- Zip-loc sandwich bags
- Zip-loc Gallon Bags

GRADE 4

- 1- 5 count set of 2 pocket divider tabs (preferably plastic)
- 1 - 2" 3 ring Trapper Keeper or binder
- 1 3 hole punch pencil bag
- 2 Large boxes of tissues
- Zip-loc sandwich bags for **Girls**, Zip-loc gallon bags for **Boys**
- 1 pump hand sanitizer --**Girls**
- Container of Clorox wipes – **Boys**
- One pair of scissors

GRADE 5

- 2 - 1/2" binders

- 1 3 hole punch pencil bag (No hard shell boxes)
- Single subject spiral notebook
- One pair of scissors
- 3 - 2 pocket pronged **PLASTIC** folders (1 red, 1 yellow, and 1 blue)

GRADE 6

- 2 boxes of tissues
- 3 - 1" Clearview binders with pockets
- 3 package of 5 subject divider tabs
- 1 – 1 ½ inch binder
- Zip-loc bags
- Clorox Wipes
- Hand Sanitizer
- 1 Roll of Paper Towels
- One pair of scissors
- 1 Red **PLASTIC** 2 pocket folder
- 1 Blue **PLASTIC** 2 pocket folder
- 1 Yellow Pronged **PLASTIC** 2 pocket folder
